## PREPARING FOR A SAFE AND HEALTHY EXP

We can't wait for your student to attend Camp EXP, Tuesday, August 6 through Saturday, August 10, 2024! We are believing for a powerful experience where our students meet with God and are spiritually fed for the school year ahead.

**Before your child's EXP experience begins**, we'd love to ask for your assistance with 1 thing that you can do to help us maintain a healthy Camp EXP environment:

1. If your child has had a fever or [Coronavirus](#) symptoms within 48 hours of departing on the bus for EXP, please contact your Youth Pastor or Youth Director ASAP. We want to take every precaution to prevent the spread of illness. They will inform you of your next steps.

## KEEPING YOUR CAMPER SAFE AT EXP

We take the health and welfare of our campers and leaders seriously, therefore we will put in place the following procedures at CAMP EXP:

1. Campers who present symptoms of COVID-19 (primarily a temperature over 100.3 F) will be immediately isolated in the infirmary. Parents will be called and next steps will be accessed, including parents coming to get their camper.
2. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the camp.
3. Carolina Point Staff will perform ongoing and routine environmental cleaning and disinfection of high-touch areas (e.g., doors, doorknobs, rails)
4. Campers generally stay with their small groups. Campers will eat, sleep, and generally sit with their small group. This greatly reduces extraneous interactions that can result in transmission of sicknesses.

We want this to be the best camp experience for everybody. If you don't feel comfortable sending your camper to EXP because of health and safety concerns, let your Youth Pastor/Director know via email before noon on July 20, 2023, and we will give you a 100% refund.
